

The Satisfaction home blend (Colombia, Costa Rica, Ethiopia and India)

- Flavours: rich, chocolate, nut, cream, caramel, fruit, citrus and a hint of spring blossom
- Aftertaste: orange, mango, liquorice, nuts and chocolate.

The TroPa Forte blend (Brazil, Mexico, Ethiopia, Togo and India)

- Flavour: rich, spicy, cream, caramel, cocoa, liquorice, laurel, fruit, citrus and a hint of peppermint
- Aftertaste: orange, peach, liquorice, nuts and cocoa.


Herbal tea 3.5
